Dear Friends in Christ,

Hopefully many of you had a chance to check out our new and improved gift shop. We thank our volunteers who have spent many hours buying, preparing the space, and learning our new cash register system.

We also start cemetery cleanups this week. Consider joining us while the weather is nice and caring for the gravesides of our faithful departed is a great corporal work of mercy.

This week we also start our month of May in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. We will be praying the Rosary before Mass every day of the week including on Sundays. Come a bit early and join us in this ancient and beautiful tradition of prayer to Mary our Mother. Here is part of Pope Saint John Paul II Letter on the Rosary:

“The Rosary, precisely because it starts with Mary's own experience, is *an exquisitely contemplative prayer*. Without this contemplative dimension, it would lose its meaning, as Pope Paul VI clearly pointed out: ‘Without contemplation, the Rosary is a body without a soul, and its recitation runs the risk of becoming a mechanical repetition of formulas, in violation of the admonition of Christ: ‘In praying do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think they will be heard for their many words’ (Mt 6:7). By its nature the

recitation of the Rosary calls for a quiet rhythm and a lingering pace, helping the individual to meditate on the mysteries of the Lord's life as seen through the eyes of her who was closest to the Lord. In this way the unfathomable riches of these mysteries are disclosed’.

“It is worth pausing to consider this profound insight of Paul VI, in order to bring out certain aspects of the Rosary which show that it is really a form of Christocentric contemplation.

‘Mary's contemplation is above all *a remembering*. We need to understand this word in the biblical sense of remembrance (*zakar*) as a making present of the works brought about by God in the history of salvation. The Bible is an account of saving events culminating in Christ himself. These events not only belong to “yesterday”; *they are also part of the “today” of salvation*.

This making present comes about above all in the Liturgy: What God accomplished centuries ago did not only affect the direct witnesses of those events, it continues to affect people in every age with its gift of grace. To some extent this is also true of every other devout approach to those events: To “remember” them in a spirit of faith and love is to be open to the grace which Christ won for us by the mysteries of his life, death and resurrection.

“Consequently, while it must be reaffirmed with the Second Vatican

Council that the Liturgy, as the exercise of the priestly office of Christ and an act of public worship, is ‘the summit to which the activity of the Church is directed and the font from which all its power flows’, it is also necessary to recall that the “spiritual life” is not limited solely to participation in the liturgy. Christians, while they are called to prayer in common, must also go to their own rooms to pray to their Father in secret (cf. Mt 6:6); indeed, according to the teaching of the Apostle, they must pray without ceasing (cf. 1Thes 5:17)’, The Rosary, in its own particular way, is part of this varied panorama of “ceaseless” prayer. If the Liturgy, as the activity of Christ and the Church, is *a saving action par excellence*, the Rosary too, as a “meditation” with Mary on Christ, is *a salutary contemplation*. By immersing us in the mysteries of the Redeemer's life, it ensures that what he has done and what the liturgy makes present is profoundly assimilated and shapes our existence.”




