

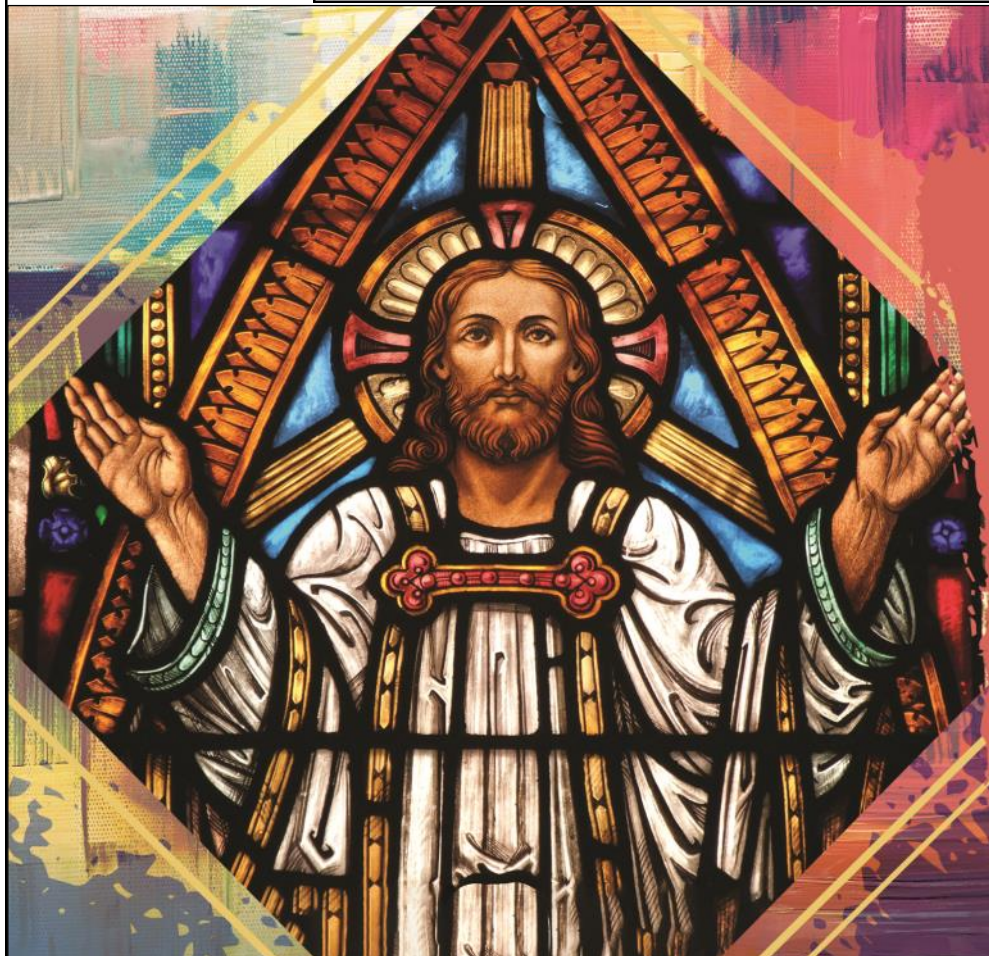

Dear Friends in Christ,

The end of the liturgical year is close at hand. Hopefully you can sense the increasing anticipation. A new liturgical year brings new life into the liturgies we celebrate. What we have is certainly an old liturgy but also a new one, for the Holy Spirit animates the worship and leads us on paths unknown to us. Next week we will celebrate the final Sunday of the liturgical year, the Solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe.

We had some nice food events these last couple weeks with the Sacred Heart Ladies Club (SHLC) Spaghetti Dinner and then the Hispanic Community's annual Kermes. I am always impressed with how many raffle items the SHLC is able to acquire each year. It is impressive. And this year after 5.5 years of failure, I finally won a raffle item! It's a homemade and hand painted birdhouse. Our Kermes also had a new feel as this year we included a live band performing throughout the evening. Thanks as well to all those who came out for our three cemetery cleanups in Volcano, Sutter Creek, and Lone. The amount of work that has been done over these last years have made each of those places shine. If you have yet to be out to one

of them in this month of November, I do encourage you to visit, as does Holy Mother Church. Walk through one of our cemeteries and pray the Rosary or the Divine Mercy Chaplet for all of our faithful departed. It is a great spiritual practice.

We have a week of events for this mid-November. Thursday is our annual Candlelight Memorial Mass at St. Katharine Drexel for all those who have passed in this last year. Friday is a Family Bowling Night at Gold Country Lanes. And then Saturday is our Advent Day of Recollection at Our Lady of the Pines. Hopefully we see you for one of those events.

Meanwhile, we have a couple projects taking place. One is finished. We have new carpet in the narthex. I personally think it is a vast improvement over our worn down beige carpet squares. The idea of the narthex, also at times having been called the vestibule or church porch, is an entrance area that assists in transitioning us from the profane to the sacred, from the outside world into the interior world of God. The idea then is that we are drawn into the space but not to stay there, but continue moving as we enter into the nave or sanctuary itself.

We are also improving the lighting outside in the parking lot area. We will be moving some of our current LED lights around and taking down some of the light poles currently in the parking lot that served well for the former car dealership feel but are less conducive to a place we call our parish home. We will hopefully see the difference in the next couple weeks, especially around the front edge of the property at the street entrances and the middle of the parking lot.

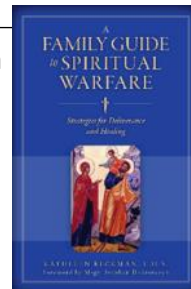
