Dear Friends in Christ,

It is Commitment Sunday! I hope these last couple weeks, outside of the drama of change, have been fruitful for you in pondering and saying yes to a life of Stewardship. There is much work to be done and only with our united effort, can the harvest be fruitful. If you don't have time or need more time to fill out your Commitment Card, you can certainly bring it next Sunday or drop it off at the Parish during the week. But this is an important work for our whole parish as we begin a new year of Stewardship.

Time, Talent, and Treasure are easy to gloss over. But when we think about it in terms of the Clear Path of Discipleship, the Core Values of Generous Service and Welcome Arms, and investing in the beauty of our Church spaces and people, I think we see how fruitful our Stewardship has been and how much more it could be. So thank you!

Now, back to this transition talk. Considering the short time frame of transition, the month in which is occurring, and Fr. Mahar's own previously scheduled plans to be away, I am going to do my best to help make things go smoothly. 


